ELECTRIC VEHICLE COMPANY RELOCATING TO ST. LUCIE COUNTY INCREASING THE RESEARCH COAST'S ALTERNATIVE ENERGY CLUSTER

PORT ST. LUCIE, FL (OCTOBER 5, 2010) – The Economic Development Council of St. Lucie County, Inc. (EDC) has assisted in the relocation to St. Lucie County of Professional Golf Car Corporation of Florida (“Pro Golf Car”), an environmentally-friendly firm that provides energy efficient alternative transportation golf, utility, and street legal vehicles. The company plans to bring 25 jobs initially, and expand to 40 jobs over the next five years, and will locate in a facility in Fort Pierce, FL.

The EDC led efforts to secure local support for the project to bring Pro Golf Car to St. Lucie County. St. Lucie County has committed to provide Pro Golf Car with property tax abatement based on the company’s job creation, capital investment and commitments, along with a Job Growth Incentive Grant. ComNet Realty spearheaded the company’s search for their corporate location. Pro Golf Car will also work with Workforce Solutions to seek qualified candidates for their jobs.

“Adding 25 jobs in this challenging economy is truly a testament to teamwork, dedication and to the foresight of Pro Golf Car’s executive team,” Larry Pelton, President of the EDC commented. “Everyone pulled together to make this happen.”

The 50,000 square foot facility will open in November at Florida Nexus Park, a 152,000 square foot mixed-use facility located at the northwest corner of I-95 and Okeechobee Road in Fort Pierce, where Pro Golf Car will house the company’s corporate headquarters, main showroom, maintenance and storage facility, and customer service for the electric vehicle industry. Harry Zuker, President of ComNet Realty, said, “Our challenge was to locate a facility that was flexible in uses to fit Pro Golf Car’s operational needs, budget and timetable. The City of Fort Pierce was instrumental in Pro Golf Car’s decision to relocate here. The EDC, Congressman Tom Rooney and Fort Pierce’s Economic Transformation Team provided great support and assistance in bringing this quality company to our market.”

“Our relocation to St. Lucie County will allow for unique local partnerships while expanding our reach regionally,” said Clifford Danley, President of Pro Golf Car. “St. Lucie County is an outstanding location for our business, and we look forward to collaborating with the increasing number of alternative energy organizations that call the Research Coast their home.”
